We expect over the next two weeks as vaccines increase and the lockdown restrictions have a positive impact, that school will be a safer place to be. With that in mind we have risk assessed the opening of nursery.

We are pleased to say that we will be opening our Nursery Classes (Mae C Jameson AM, PM & 30 hours children) on **Monday 22nd February 2021.** 



We welcome all our nursery children back in school from this day.

We will be opening the classes for our usual times Nursery AM 8.45am -11.30am Nursery PM 12.15pm – 3.00pm

All reception classes will be open full time for any child;

- who has at least one parent as a key worker
- or who may have difficulty engaging with remote education at home (for example due to a lack of computer devices or quiet space to study)
- or where it is felt a child is vulnerable

as per Universal Free School Meals. We ask that children do not bring anything into school except their coats and a book bag with their book and home school diary in.

Any children in other year groups who do not have a place in a bubble and you feel they need one, based on the above criteria, please contact me and we will be booking extra places from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

There are still limited places in other year groups, as the teachers are still teaching the children remotely, so children may only turn up in year groups 1 to 6 if you have written confirmation of a place, or your child had a place before half term.

Children will be expected in full uniform. However, if they have grown out of jumpers, or school shoes, we are flexible if you need time to buy new ones and understand if this may not be the first day back.

We will be keeping within our COVID prevention arrangements and any further changes the government puts in place.
