Dear Parents/Carers,

With the expected high temperatures forecasted for next week we would like to make you aware of the measures and changes the school are putting in place to support our children and staff.

- Children will be able to attend school in their PE kit and trainers for the whole week. If this needs washing, please wear a plain black or white T-shirt and shorts until they are clean (not non-school uniform).
- Children **MUST** bring a hat and wear sun cream. A bottle of sun cream with their name on can also be brought into school.
- Classrooms will have windows and doors open early to allow air to flow and blinds will be shut.
- Children to have plenty of water and will be encouraged to fill their water bottles up regularly.
- When playing outside they will be encouraged to sit in the shade, playtimes and lunch may be moved to be earlier in the day to avoid the highest temperatures.
- Children will not take part in PE or other strenuous activity.
- Children may be kept inside if the temperature rises to extremes.
- Staff will be looking out for any signs of heat exhaustion or dehydration.

We will endeavor to follow the Government guidance and to keep parents informed as the week progresses and if any changes need to be made.
