Dear Parents/Carers

We are seeing an increased number of children not wearing the correct uniform in school.

The Florence Nightingale Academy has strict guidelines on school dress and all pupils are expected to wear the full uniform.

The wearing of our distinctive uniform gives students a sense of 'belonging', helps foster pride in the school and stops students coming to school in inappropriate clothing or footwear. It also prepares them for secondary school.

All children should be wearing sensible flat black school shoes NOT trainers.

All children – From Year 1 to Year 6 should be wearing a tie.
