Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 3, Lynx and Grey Wolf, Autumn 2



English

Our core text is 'Into the Forest' by Anthony Browne. Other texts will include 'Jack and The Baked Beanstalk' by Colin Simpson. We will be writing a selection of different genres including a narrative, a playscript and a nonchronological report. We will be learning to use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions in our writing.

Mathematics

In our addition and subtraction topic we will be learning to add and subtract two 3-digit numbers by crossing 10 and 100, subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number with exchange and estimate and check answers to calculations using the inverse operation. In our multiplication and division topic we will be learning to multiply and divide by 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10.

Science

We will be exploring rocks and fossils and answering the question 'How are all rocks different?' We will learn to identify and classify rocks and compare different kinds of rocks on the basis of physical properties. We will investigate the durability, density and permeability of rocks. We will write up our investigation on rocks. We will explore how and why rocks might have changed over time.
